

KIDS CHURCH CO-LEADER



What:

Kids Church includes Reception and years 1-4, together in the hall.

- We're checked in at the door, so we know who's in the building.
- We're welcomed by our host - the main session leader.
- We kick off with a fun time of praise and worship.
- We have a storytime together, led by the host/session leader.
- We break into groups for an activity-based response - perhaps a craft or a game.
- We come back together for some interactive and creative prayer.

We'll be following the same themes as everyone in the church building, so that we can grow in what we learn, together.

When:

We'd ask you to be there 30 minutes before the start of the service to familiarise yourself with what your group will be doing, ask any questions, and pray with others and for 15 minutes (or as long as it takes to tidy up) at the end.

What happens:

You'll be worshipping alongside the kids, and enjoying the storytime together, encouraging interaction as needed!

There will be two co-leaders for three different year groups (Reception, years 1-2, years 3-4). You'll be asked to get stuck into leading the (pre-prepared) age-appropriate response, which may be helping with a craft, facilitating a game or something else.

Time Commitment:

Can you help at one (or even two) of these 5 Sundays? We would like to offer kids church provision for both our 9.15 and 11am services.

We would love it if you could help at both services, being at church from 9 to 12.30. But if you can just make one, do just let us know which you can do.

Safe-guarding Commitment

We ask everyone who works with children at All Saints to have a DBS check and to undertake our safeguarding training. First-time training includes two, straightforward online modules, which you can do in your own time (roughly an hour each. Those doing refresher training just need to complete one module). If you haven't already completed this, we'll ask you to do so before your session.
